

Specific features of hormonal pattern in women with cutaneous manifestations of hiperandrogenism

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Summary

Also hiperandrogenism is a frequent cause of acne and menstrual diseases in girls at puberty, the disease is often misdiagnosed and neglected.

Up to 10% of women have hiperandrogenemia, being the most frequent endocrine disease in women.

By far the most common cause of hiperandrogenemia is represented by polycystic ovary syndrome, with its numerous complications: infertility, diabetes mellitus, dyslipidemia, endometrial cancer, ischemic heart disease.

The correct diagnosis of those illnesses, their treatment and etiology has a major impact upon dermatologists as well as upon pediatricians and endocrinologists.
